

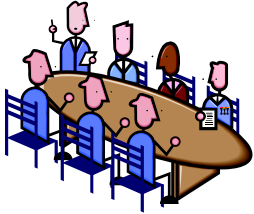

Boy Scouts of America National Commissioner



Our club has a long history with the Boy Scouts of America. In fact, we were the chartering organization of the Quivira Council in 1918. Some of the topics that Mr. Perez will share with our club include the 100th anniversary of scouting, the new BSA stamp and coin, their new High Adventure Base/National Jamboree site and the strategic vision of the organization at the national level.

Tico Perez serves as national commissioner of the Boy Scouts of America. An attorney and consultant in private practice, he is also a political analyst for the local NBC and Telemundo affiliates, as well as a talk-radio host for the Cox Radio

affiliate and the ESPN en Espanol affiliate in Orlando, Florida.

Perez is past president of the BSA's Central Florida Council, SR-4, and Southern Region. He serves as vice chairman of the National Order of the Arrow Committee and is a member of the Hispanic Initiatives Task Force.

For his distinguished service to Scouting, Perez has received the Silver Buffalo Award, the Silver Antelope Award, the Silver Beaver Award, the Order of the Arrow's Distinguished Service Award, and the Distinguished Eagle Scout Award. Perez has also been awarded the Whitney M. Young and Vale la Pena awards for service to the African American and Hispanic Scouting communities, respectively.

In Florida, Perez serves as a member of the State University System Board of Governors, where he chairs the Budget and Finance Committee. He has led the boards of directors of the Greater Orlando Chamber of Commerce, the Orlando Utilities Commission, United Arts of Central Florida, and University of Central Florida Alumni Association, to name a few. *Florida Trend* magazine named him one of the state's most influential leaders.

Perez and his wife, Donna, reside in Orlando.

WRCF Board Releases Mission Statement And Guiding Principles

The Wichita Rotary Charitable Fund (WRCF) is the funding arm for many of our club's service projects. As a 501 (c) (3), our voluntary contributions are tax deductible. The WRCF's current spending policy allows for 75% of member contributions from the prior fiscal year and 5% of a trailing 20 quarter average of the corpus to be used for club projects. That translates to almost \$100,000 a year! If you are currently contributing to the WRCF - thank you. If you are not contributing but would like to, please call Curtis in the Rotary office to discuss giving options.

Mission

It is the mission of the Wichita Rotary Charitable Fund to seek funds through gifts, donations and other means, and to manage and distribute those funds in a manner that will support and advance selected programs of the Rotary Club of Wichita, Inc.

Guiding Principles

- The WRCF Board of Directors shall manage the WRCF pursuant to the WRCF Bylaws. The Board shall consist of 9 directors serving on 3-year staggered terms. The Board of Directors shall include the President, President-Elect and Past President of the Rotary Club of Wichita, Inc. as well as the Past WRCF President. The remaining Directors shall be current members of the Rotary Club of Wichita, Inc.
- The WRCF shall hold meetings on a regular basis throughout its fiscal year. Such meetings shall be held no less frequently than once every fiscal year quarter.
- The WRCF shall maintain a current written spending policy to ensure the continuity and longevity of the WRCF.
- All funding requests made to the WRCF shall be subject to the WRCF Board of Directors' review and consideration.
- The WRCF on an annual basis, in accordance with its spending policy, shall determine the amounts to be distributed and approve a budget for the subsequent fiscal year.
- The WRCF shall maintain a current written investment policy to provide for prudent and responsible investment, growth and management of the assets of the WRCF.
- The WRCF shall review and revise as necessary its principles of operation on a regular basis.
- The WRCF Board of Directors shall make a periodic review of the Investment Manager.
