### February 4 — Diane Kessel Knight, Rotary International



Diane Kessel Knight is a third generation Rotarian who joined Rotary in Addison, Texas in 1990. She has been in Rotary clubs in Naperville, IL and Golden, CO and is currently a member of the Ft. Collins (CO) Breakfast Rotary club. Diane is a Major Donor to the Rotary Foundation and member of the Paul Harris Society, the White Hat Society and the Rotary International Foundation Bequest Society. She served as District Governor in 2004-2005.

Diane led a GSE Team to Sao Paulo, Brazil in 1998. She also has a passion for RYLA and has served as both a counselor and RYLA Chair and has been active in three International RYLA conferences. In August of 2002, Diane chaired the first "Young RYLA" program for middle school students. She is excited about helping Rotary grow its membership. Diane is serving on her club's membership committee, and has served as a Regional Rotary International Membership Coordinator for Zone 25 from 2007-2010. She also loves to train and has trained Presidents at Presidents Elect Training (PETS), incoming Governors Elect and Nominee at Zone Institutes and Governors Elect from around the world at the International Assembly in San Diego in 2010 and 2011.

In one of her most memorable Rotary experiences, Diane participated in the Climb for Children 2000, a project of the Evergreen Rotary Foundation, where she raised over \$20,000 and climbed Mt. Kilimanjaro, the highest point in Africa, to benefit a hospital in Arusha, Tanzania. Diane was honored with Rotary International's Service above Self Award in 2002.

### February 11 — Skip Yowell, Co-Founder of JanSport, a Division of VF Outdoor, Inc.



Skip Yowell co-founded *JanSport* in 1967 in Seattle, WA, while in search of the perfect hiking pack. He is credited with creating the #1 selling day pack in the world, as well as the first dome tent, waist-suspension flexible frame pack, travel pack and panel-load daypack. A Kansas native, Yowell has traveled the world giving presentations on the *JanSport* heritage, including expeditions and adventure travel in Tibet, Everest, Kangchenjunga, Kilimanjaro and many other destinations. Yowell retired in December 2010 after 43 years with the company he helped create.

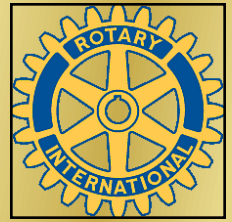
