Skip Yowell co-founded *JanSport* in 1967 in Seattle, WA, while in search of the perfect hiking pack. He is credited with creating the #1 selling day pack in the world, as well as the first dome tent, waist-suspension flexible frame pack, travel pack and panel-load daypack. A Kansas native, Yowell has traveled the world giving presentations on the *JanSport* heritage, including expeditions and adventure travel in Tibet, Everest, Kangchenjunga, Kili-manjaro and many other destinations. Yowell retired in December 2010 after 43 years with the company he helped create.

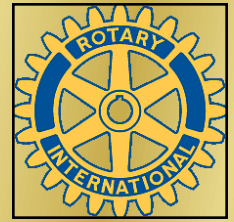
