March 25 — City Councilman Pete Meitzner
"The Heartland Flyer"



Pete Meitzner is a lifelong resident of Wichita. He attended Kapaun Mt. Carmel High School and graduated from Wichita State University with a degree in Business Administration. Meitzner was employed in the banking industry in Wichita for 13 years before venturing into the world of entrepreneurship 20 years ago when he started a telecom company.

At the close of this month, Meitzner marks the completion of his second year on the Wichita City Council. As the representative of District 2, he has developed a keen interest in the city's budget and capital improvements. Meitzner's concern for the short and long-term debt of Wichita has heightened his interest in economic development.

In 2012, Councilman Meitzner was designated as the city's representative to study the feasibility of returning passenger rail service to Wichita. His presentation to Rotary will follow his March 14 update of the Heartland Flyer's prospects to both the Kansas House and Senate Transportation committee in Topeka.

Meitzner is active in community affairs and currently serves as the president of The Lord's Diner Advisory Board. He and his wife, Suzi, have two teenage children.

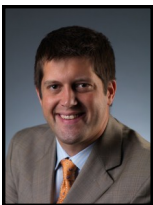

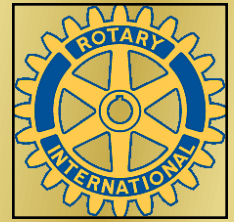
April 8 — Jon Rolph Sasnak Management

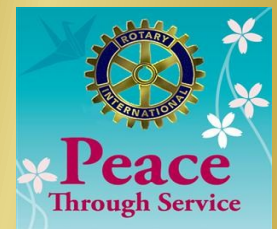

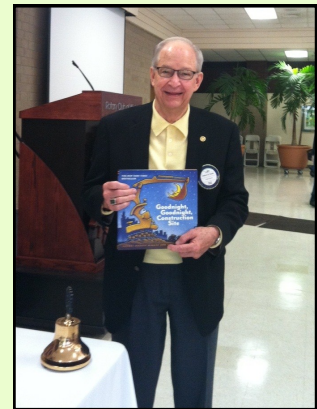
