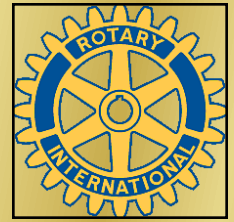
April 15—Steven Van Zant—Case New Holland

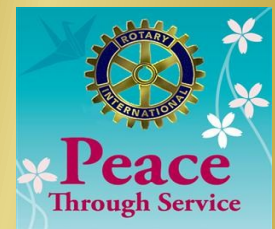
