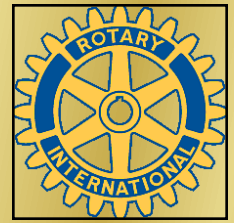


### June 10 - Wayne Bryan and Music Theatre Performers

Wayne Bryan is enjoying his 25th season with Music Theatre of Wichita (MTW), where he has produced more than 100 Broadway-scale musicals, including dozens for which he also served as director or performer.

Raised in southern California, Wayne began his professional career as both actor and director at San Diego's Old Globe Theatre while stationed as a Navy officer in Coronado. Wayne performed on Broadway in *Good News!*, *Rodgers and Hart*, and *Tintypes*, and on television in such shows as "M\*A\*S\*H" (CBS), "American History" (PBS), and "Keystone" (A&E). He also directed productions for theatres all across the country before coming to Kansas, but he feels he's doing his most challenging and rewarding work now. Wayne is co-author with Mark Madama of a revised version of the collegiate musical *Good News!*. The 1993 Wichita premiere has been followed by more than 300 subsequent productions around the U.S., Canada and Great Britain, plus an internationally acclaimed cast album.

In what has become an annual tradition, Wayne and some of the troupe from MTW will share a preview of the upcoming season with our club. You won't want to miss this entertaining program.
