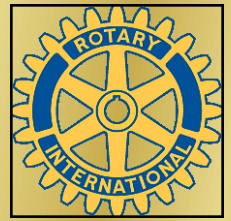

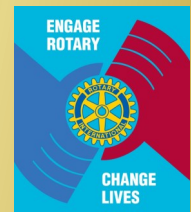

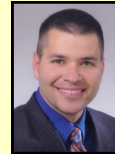
November 4 — Dr. Josh Umbehr / Dr. Doug Nunamaker — AtlasMD

AtlasMD is Wichita's first concierge medical practice, established to provide family health care that is immediate, easily affordable and very personal. Concierge medicine is defined as a relationship between a patient and a primary care physician, in which the patient pays an annual fee or retainer.



Dr. Umbehr was raised in Alma, Kansas, and attended Kansas State University, where he obtained his undergraduate degree in human nutritional sciences. He graduated from the University of Kansas School of Medicine and completed his family medicine residency at Wesley Medical Center. After completing his training and becoming a board certified family physician, he opened AtlasMD. Dr. Umbehr resides in Wichita with his wife Lisa and their three children, Katelyn, Paige and Cole.

Dr. Nunamaker was born in Joplin, Missouri, and raised in Manhattan, Kansas. He attended Pittsburg State University and graduated magna cum laude with a bachelor of science degree. He graduated from the University of Kansas School of Medicine and completed his residency at Wesley Family Medicine. After his residency, Dr. Nunamaker joined Mid-Kansas Inpatient Physicians as a hospitalist before joining AtlasMD. He resides in Wichita with his wife and son.

Ready, set, almost time to go. We need your help to make it happen. Stephanie Flaming is leading our effort this year to get dictionaries into the hands of Wichita school children. It is not the same old program!

In order to maximize the number of books we supply in the RIF program, we needed to focus our giving to those most in need of dictionaries. So this year we will distribute 2,700 dictionaries to third-graders in the 33 Title I schools only. This means completely new assignments need to be made.

Metro Courier has again generously agreed to store and deliver the boxes of books to the schools. The plan is to distribute the books by classroom. We will need perhaps two or three volunteers for each school so the books can be simultaneously distributed in each third-grade room.

WHERE DO YOU COME IN? We need volunteers to arrive at Metro Courier at 4949 S. Lulu by 10 a.m., Friday, November 29, to affix the Rotary sticker to each book. This process will take about 2 hours, and it's an excellent way to get rid of your Thanksgiving food hangover. Family and friends are welcome!
