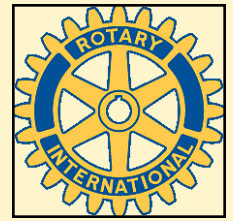

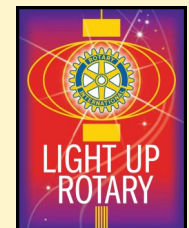

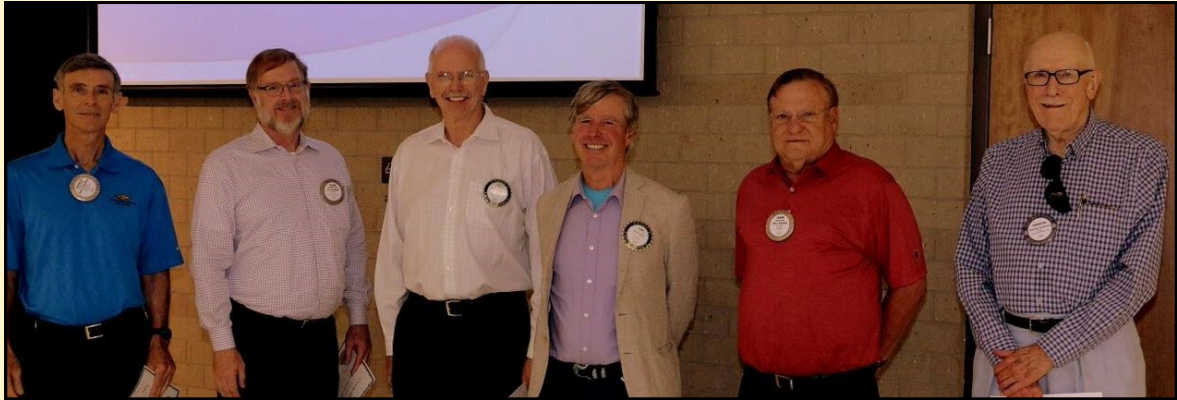
### NEW MEMBER INTRODUCTION ON MONDAY
