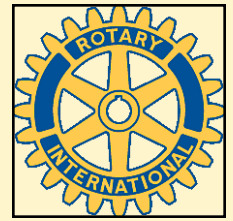

October 5 — Career Day — Steve Sax Former Major League Baseball Player CEO of Steve Sax Foundation

Steve Sax will draw on his experience as a major league baseball player to connect with the high school students hosted by our club on Career Day.

Sax played professional baseball for eighteen years, during which time he played for the Los Angeles Dodgers, New York Yankees, Chicago White Sox and Oakland A's. He was the 1982 National League rookie of the year, five-time All-Star and two-time World Series Champion.

In 2001, Steve redirected his efforts in order to help individuals and families manage their finances in his role as vice president of investments at the Royal Bank of Canada. He later founded the Steve Sax Foundation with the mission to inspire and mentor youth and to provide college scholarships for underprivileged youth.

Sax is a professional motivational speaker, executive business and life coach and a member of the National Speakers Association. He is an on-air contributor for Sirius Satellite Radio and MLB.com. He has appeared as a guest star on several television shows including Good Morning America and Hannity's Great America. In addition, he has been a guest on Late Night with David Letterman and the Larry King Show.

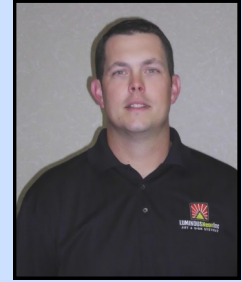
