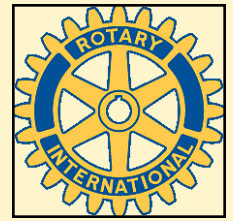

Topic: *A Day in the Life of a Clydesdale at the Kansas State Fair*

Scott Schwindaman has been president and CEO at Lubrication Engineers (LE) since 2007, having started as a laboratory technician in 1981 while he was still in college and working his way up through the ranks. Today, he oversees a company that has more than 100 employees in the U.S. and a large network of independent consultants and distributors who sell LE products and services worldwide.

Since 1951, LE has manufactured and distributed high-performance lubricants made of highly refined base oils and proprietary additives. LE also offers a full line of lubrication reliability products and services. LE's domestic facilities include a manufacturing facility, laboratory, warehouse and office in Wichita; a sales, customer service and technical support office in Fort Worth, Texas; and warehouses in Knoxville, Tenn. and Las Vegas, Nev. He also serves as vice president of Alpha BioSystems, Inc., a small upstart company that manufactures all-natural, nontoxic products for improving soil health and yielding stronger crops and vegetation. In a side business that grew out of a family hobby, Scott and his family raise, train and breed horses at their Cowskin Creek Clydesdale farm in Goddard.

Scott is a member of the Wichita Metro Chamber of Commerce's Board of Directors and is the Vice Chairman of the Entrepreneur Task Force for the Chamber's Leadership Council. He also sits on the Advisory Board for the Center for Entrepreneurship at Wichita State University.

Scott holds a bachelor's degree in industrial technology from Wichita State University. He and his wife, Janet, have three grown children and three grandchildren.
