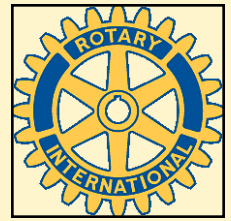

**August 22 — Jeffrey Toobin — Author, Lawyer, Senior Legal Analyst for CNN Worldwide and Staff Writer for the NY Times**

**Topic: *American Heiress: The Wild Saga of the Kidnapping, Crimes and Trial of Patty Hearst***

Jeffrey Toobin is the bestselling author of *The Nine*, *Too Close to Call*, *A Vast Conspiracy* and *The Run of His Life*. He is also a staff writer at The New Yorker and the senior legal analyst at CNN. Toobin earned his bachelor's degree from Harvard College and graduated magna cum laude from Harvard Law School, where he was an editor of the Harvard Law Review. He lives with his family in New York.

Toobin's new book, *American Heiress: The Wild Saga of the Kidnapping, Crimes and Trial of Patty Hearst*, is the story which defined a decade in which America seemed to be suffering a collective nervous breakdown. Based on more than a hundred interviews and thousands of previously secret documents, this book recounts the insanity of the times (there was an average of 1,500 terrorist bombings a year in the early 1970s.) Toobin portrays the lunacy of the half-baked radicals of the SLA and the toxic mix of sex, politics, and violence that swept up Patricia Hearst and recreates her melodramatic trial. *American Heiress* examines the life of a young woman who suffered an unimaginable trauma and then made the startling decision to join her captors' crusade. Or did she?

**August 29 — John Dascher — CEO — e2e Accelerator**

**Topic: *A Vision Becomes Reality: e2e Accelerator and Its Impact on the Wichita Entrepreneurial Ecosystem***

Before accepting the role of President and CEO of the e2e Accelerator, John Dascher worked in Denmark as an investment director for two early-stage venture capital funds with a combined capital base of over \$200 million. During this time, he held chairmanships, CEO and CFO positions with several companies in his portfolio. He enjoys being an active mentor to the entrepreneurial teams and has played instrumental roles in establishing operations in many of these companies.

Before moving to Denmark, Dascher helped establish and operate investment funds and technology accelerators in Texas, Delaware and South Florida. He began his career in technology acceleration and venture capital investing in 1997 at the internationally renowned Ben Franklin Technology Partners in Philadelphia. Prior to this, he worked as an aerospace project engineer with a tier-one supplier to the global leaders in the military, defense and aviation industries.

Dascher holds a B.S. in applied physics from Albright College in Reading, Pennsylvania and an MBA in finance from the LeBow College of Business at Drexel University in Philadelphia. He is also a graduate of the Venture Capital Institute and a member of the International Mensa Society.

John and his wife, Helle Isen Olesen, have three sons. He enjoys being physically active and has completed three marathons and two half ironman triathlons. He also enjoys traveling with his family.

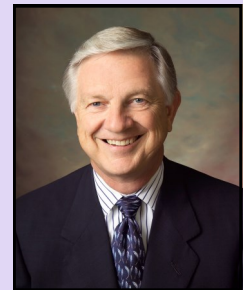
### MEETING NOTES — AUGUST 15, 2016
