September 26 — Terri Moses
Executive Director of Safety Services for
Wichita Public Schools

Topic: *Protecting Our Future*

Terri Moses is a Kansas native, raised in a rural community in Northeast Kansas. She moved to Wichita to attend Wichita State University. Upon graduation from WSU, she joined the Wichita Police Department and worked her way through the ranks of the department. In 1995, she became the first female to attain the rank of deputy chief. In 2013, Moses retired from the Wichita Police Department after 32 years of service. Immediately following retirement, she continued her public safety career by becoming the executive director of the Safety Services Department for Wichita public schools.

While working in the Wichita Police Department, Moses returned to Wichita State and received her master's degree in 1990. She is also a graduate of the FBI National Academy and has received numerous awards throughout her public safety career, including the Kansas Chiefs of Police Silver award. Moses was named a Woman of Distinction by the Wichita Area Girl Scouts in 1997 and as one of the Top Twenty Women in Business by the Wichita Business Journal in 2003. Moses received a Parentage Award from the Wichita Section of The National Council of Negro Women, Inc. in 2004 and was named Outstanding Criminal Justice Alumni by Wichita State University in 2008. In 2014, she received the Recognition Award from the Wichita State University Alumni Association.

Owner, The Workroom and JK Design ICT

Topic: *#LOVEICT: A Walk Through The Douglas Design District*

Janelle King exhibits a passionate love of the city and all things art.

Originally from the Kansas City area, King holds a bachelor's degree in business administration with a major in marketing from Kansas State University. She cut her teeth in the interior design business with Abode Home before the store closed in 2010, after which she began her independent design business JK Design and never looked back. In 2013, she opened The Workroom which is a sewing workroom for home textiles including: custom drapery, bedding, pillows, headboards, & more with a retail front of local art, artisan accessories and Wichita Flag Swag merchandise. The Workroom is home to the Second Saturday Artisan Market which is in its third year and runs from April through October featuring dozens of local artists, live music and food trucks.

As a board member of the Douglas Design District since 2014, King has been driving a cultural shift in the area, striving to change the perception of Wichita among both residents and outsiders. In 2015, she launched Avenue Art Days, which is a local initiative to install art throughout the district and engaged both volunteers and artists to proudly showcase their artistic talents.

Janelle is the busy mother of two daughters, ages 8 and 13.
