Michael O'Donnell was elected to the Wichita City Council in April 2011 and has served as a Kansas State Senator since 2013. During his tenure in the Kansas State Senate, O'Donnell has served on multiple senate committees including Regulatory Board and Commissions, Ways and Means, Education Budget and Ethics and Elections. He is a graduate of Friends University with a degree in political science and currently serves as the chairman of the Sedgwick County Young Republicans club. O'Donnell is on the board of the Wichita YMCA and Grace Baptist Church and is active as a volunteer in numerous community events.



In 2001, Tim Norton was elected to the Sedgwick County Commission and has served in this capacity since. Prior, he served on the Haysville City Council from 1987 to 1996 and as mayor of Haysville from 1996 to 2000. In 1999, following an F-5 tornado which struck his community, Norton decided to dedicate his life full-time to public service. This decision followed 22 years in the business world managing Target stores.

Norton has served on numerous municipal and county commissions and boards, including charitable organizations. He holds a bachelor of science degree in journalism from Arkansas State University and a masters degree in adult education from Newman University. Tim and his wife, Susan, are long-time Haysville residents and have five grown children.

Topic: A Vision for a Thriving University in an Uncertain Higher Education Landscape

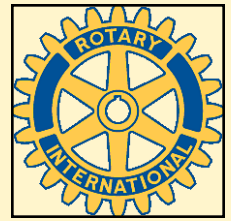
Dr. Amy Bragg Carey was selected by the board of trustees as president of Friends University in March of 2015 and began her role on July 1st. Dr. Carey comes to the university from Saint Paul, Minnesota, where she had served as the vice president of institutional advancement for the University of Northwestern since 2003. As vice president she led in the area of advancement for the university and media division. Her prior responsibilities at the University of Northwestern included oversight in the areas of marketing and communications, alumni and parent relations, admissions and financial aid.

Dr. Carey's prior professional experience includes four years (1999-2003) with Minnehaha Academy in Minneapolis, as director of development. Additionally, Dr. Carey spent 13 years with the HealthEast Foundation of Saint Paul.

Dr. Carey served on the national standards committee for the ECFA (Evangelical Council for Financial Accountability) and is past chair of the Chief Institutional Advancement Officers Commission for the CCCU (Coalition for Christian Colleges and Universities). She is past president of the Minnesota Planned Giving Council, a professional development association, and has served on a number of community and non-profit boards.

Dr. Carey holds an Ed.D from Azusa Pacific University in higher education leadership, a M.A. degree in philanthropy and development from St. Mary's University in Winona, Minnesota and an undergraduate degree in communications from Bethel University in Minnesota.
