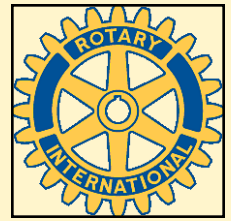


Dr. Mark Bartel is in demand as a versatile conductor and music educator. He is also artistic director and conductor of the Wichita Chamber Chorale. From 2006-2011 he was the artistic director of the Wichita Community Children's Choir and he is a frequent guest conductor for honor choirs and festivals for singers of all ages. He holds the master of music and master of sacred music degrees from Southern Methodist University in Dallas, TX, and the doctor of musical arts degree from the Eastman School of Music in Rochester, N.Y.

Choral music has been at the heart of the Friends University experience from the university's inception in 1898, and since 1924 the Friends University Singing Quakers have represented this tradition at home and abroad. 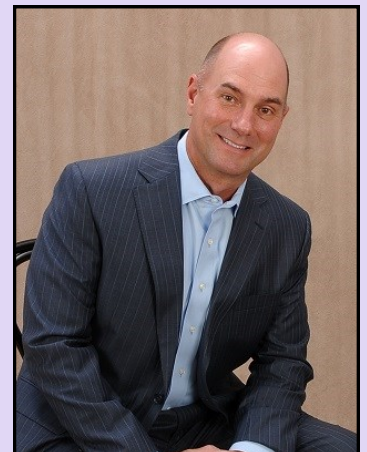
### MEETING NOTES — NOVEMBER 21, 2016
