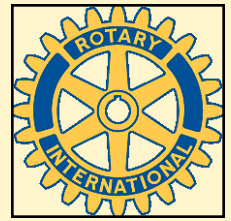

### February 6

**Daniel Hege, Music Director and Conductor of the Wichita Symphony Orchestra**  
**Wayne Bryan, Producing Artistic Director of Music Theatre Wichita**  
**Topic: *Carousel in Concert - A Musical Collaboration***

Daniel Hege and Wayne Bryan will share some of the background of the show *Carousel* and its music and will offer insight into the unique presentation that is being created for Wichita audiences.

For its first ever full-scale collaboration, Wichita Symphony Orchestra, led by Maestro Daniel Hege, and Music Theatre Wichita, led by producing artistic director Wayne Bryan, are presenting Rodgers and Hammerstein's classic *Carousel* in a semi-staged production at Century II Concert Hall, February 11 and 12. The cast stars Broadway veteran Matt Bogart as Billy Bigelow, with other leading roles played by Kerry Conte, Katie Banks-Todd, Hannah Fernandes, Matt Udland and Steve Hitchcock. The Act II ballet will be performed by two New Yorkers with Wichita connections, Whitney Cooper and Nicholas Palmquist who also choreograph. The cast will also feature a 40-member ensemble from Butler County Community College, under the direction of Matt Udland, with musical staging by Joshua Larson.

*Carousel* was Richard Rodgers' own favorite score, with the original 1945 production running almost 900 performances, and then becoming a successful film for 20th Century Fox. Songs include *June Is Bustin' Out All Over*, *If I Loved You*, *You'll Never Walk Alone* and *The Carousel Waltz*.



The 2016-2017 season marks Daniel Hege's seventh as music director and conductor of the Wichita Symphony Orchestra. Hege is the seventh music director in the Orchestra's 73-year history. He has been widely recognized as one of America's finest conductors, earning critical acclaim for his fresh interpretations of the standard repertoire and for his commitment to creative programming.



Wayne Bryan is beginning his 30th season as producing artistic director for Music Theatre Wichita. In the course of his tenure here, Music Theatre has grown from a theatre with a budget of \$800,000 a year to the most highly subscribed non-profit arts organization in Kansas, with a budget of over \$4 million.

### February 13 — Dr. Chwen Sheu

**Associate Dean for Academic Programs, College of Business Administration, Kansas State University**

**Topic: *National Culture and Business Practices in China***



Dr. Chwen Sheu received his doctorate in Operations Management from The Ohio State University. He is nationally and internationally recognized in the field of operations and supply chain management with a focus on supply chain relationship, outsourcing, manufacturing sustainability and global manufacturing management. He has authored or co-authored over 150 refereed journals and proceedings articles. Dr. Sheu's work has received numerous best paper and research award honors from academic organizations and profession meetings. Dr. Sheu has also received honors in teaching at the national, university and college levels, and he has taught supply chain management to various groups of corporate executives in China and Taiwan.

Dr. Sheu has served as the president of the Global Manufacturing Research Group and is currently the vice president of education for the Council of Supply Chain Management Professionals in Kansas City. He has consulted for more than 40 firms, including Boeing, China Mobile, Western Resources, Taipei Computer Association, Motorola and CSCS, in the areas of supply chain management, continuous improvement and project management.

Dr. Sheu has been a faculty member at Kansas State University since 1990. He currently holds the Paul Edgerley Chair in College of Business Administration and is a full professor in operations and supply chain management.
