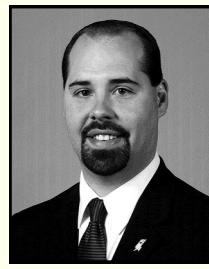

June 12 — Wayne Bryan, Producing Artistic Director with the Wichita Music Theatre Performers

Wayne Bryan celebrates his 30th year with Music Theatre Wichita (MTW) this summer as producing artistic director. Not only is he responsible for having produced over 150 Broadway-scale musicals, he also has served as director or performer in multiple productions. While stationed as a Navy officer in Coronado, CA, Wayne began his professional career as both actor and director. His credits include Broadway productions of *Good News!*, *Rodgers and Hart*, and *Tintypes*, touring companies, and TV appearances on such shows as **M*A*S*H**, *American History* and *Keystone*. His directing credits include award-winning productions on both coasts. In collaboration with co-author Mark Madama, he revised the collegiate musical *Good News!*, whose 1993 Wichita premiere was followed by over 300 subsequent productions around the US, Canada, and Great Britain. Unique to many regional theatres around the country, MTW builds the sets and costumes for many of its productions and rents them to other theatres in the US, Canada and Europe.

The reputation for production excellence has attracted Disney to give permission to showcase multiple productions including two this summer — *Newsies* and *The Hunchback of Notre Dame*. The theme for the 2017 is MTW Goes to the Movies. Additional productions will be *Thoroughly Modern Millie*, *Seven Brides for Seven Brothers* and *Hairspray*.

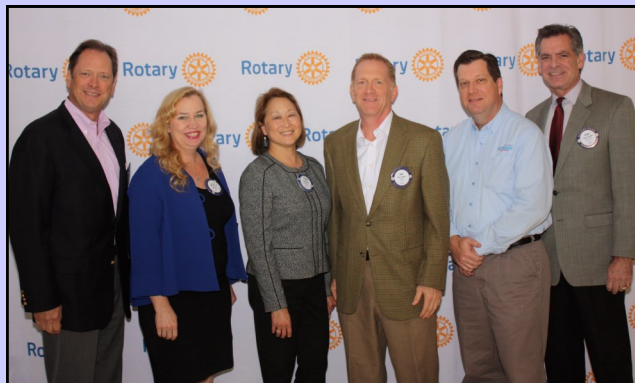
