June 19 — Retired Rear Admiral Jeffrey R. Penfield

Topic: Commissioning of the USS Wichita

Since the first USS Wichita launched almost 80 years ago, the ship has been our city's tie and claim to the ocean, charging through the sea bearing Wichita's name and legacy. During that time, Wichita has opened its arms to the men and women who have served on the USS Wichita and we will continue to do so. The third and latest ship to bear Wichita's name launched in Wisconsin in September, 2016. This ship is a littoral combat ship, one of the Navy's fastest, lightest and technologically advanced ships. It is part of the Freedom class of warships which can be used as a small assault transport with a flight deck and hangar space. And it will carry the personal touches of its namesake - books, postcards and mementos of Wichita. Retired Rear Admiral Jeffrey Penfield will discuss the new ship and how the Wichita community can be part of the success and legacy of what many are calling "The finest warship of this century."

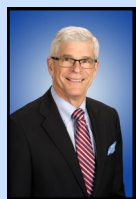
Rear Adm. Jeffrey Penfield was commissioned in October 1982 via the Aviation Officer Candidate Program and earned his Navy Wings of Gold in June 1984. His operational assignments include Strike Fighter Squadron (VFA 136) as a plankowner, VFA-94 and command of VFA-115. While in command, he deployed on the maiden F/A-18E Super Hornet cruise participating in Operations Enduring Freedom, Southern Watch and the initial combat phase of Operation Iraqi Freedom. His shore tour assignments include Training Squadron (VT-23), Air Test and Evaluation Squadron (VX) 5, Super Hornet Fleet Introduction Team and VX-9 where he was the lead operational test director for the F/A-18E/F operational evaluation.

Penfield's previous flag assignment was commander, Fleet Readiness Centers. Penfield has over 4,000 flight hours and 750 carrier landings. He has been recognized as the 1995 Commander, Naval Air Force Pacific Fleet Pilot of the Year and the National Defense Industrial Association Navy Military Tester of the Year for 1999.

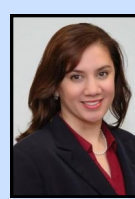
June 26 — Rotary Club and WRCF Passing of the Gavels

Outgoing Club President Tammy Allen and Incoming President Jeff Van Sickle

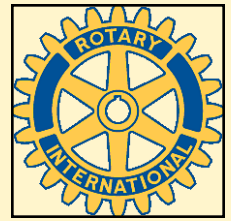
