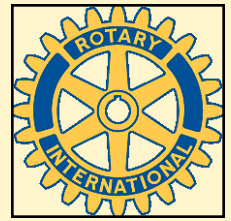

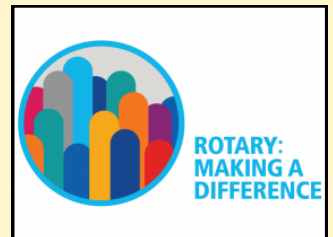

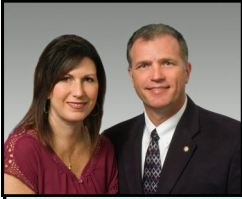

She has spent her professional career in the fields of international education and the arts. Shan has been with Tallgrass since its start, joining the first programming committee in 2003. She has held various leadership positions in programming throughout the years. Currently, as director of acquisitions, Shan's focus is on researching, reviewing and booking films for the annual festival and year-round screening.

Shan will be joined by Kate Gondwe Mpanje, a Malawian-American filmmaker who graduated this year from Wichita Collegiate High School. She was a member of the Tallgrass Emerging Programming Apprenticeship program for secondary school students in 2015-16. She focuses on telling unique raw stories and has an interest in documentaries, narratives and music videos. Kate will attend Emerson College in Boston this fall.
