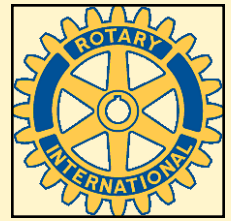

Choral music has been at the heart of the Friends University experience from the university's inception in 1898, and since 1924 the Friends University Singing Quakers have represented this tradition of excellence and faith at home and abroad. The choir performs frequently with the Wichita Symphony Orchestra and Chorus. Since 2005, the Singing Quakers have been conducted by Friends University Director of Choral Music, Dr. Mark Bartel. Friends University degree programs are designed to nurture students' passion for music, and to prepare for vocations in education, performance and ministry. Four choirs perform a wide variety of music ranging from standard choral literature to vocal jazz to choral-orchestral masterworks. Generous vocal scholarships are awarded on the basis of audition to majors as well as non-majors. Under the leadership of Interim Chair, Dr. Cecil J. Riney, the Division of Fine Arts offers degrees in music, art and ballet.

Dr. Mark Bartel is in demand as a versatile conductor and music educator. This season he begins his 13th year as Director of Choral Music at Friends University and Conductor of the Singing Quakers. He is Artistic Director and Conductor of the Wichita Chamber Chorale and from 2006-2011 he served as the Artistic Director of the Wichita Community Children's Choir. Dr. Bartel is a frequent guest conductor for honor choirs and festivals for singers of all and currently serves as President-elect of the Kansas Choral Directors Association. He holds the Master of Music and Master of Sacred Music degrees from Southern Methodist University in Dallas, TX, and the Doctor of Musical Arts degree from the Eastman School of Music in Rochester, N.Y.
