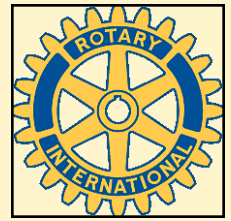

**TOPIC: *Starkey, Inc. Services for Disability***

Colin McKenney has served as the CEO of Starkey since 2012. Prior to that he served as the president and CEO of Multi Community Diversified Services and Cartridge King, both based out of McPherson. Colin was born in Wichita and has lived in the area nearly all his life. He graduated from Valley Center High School, earned a bachelor's degree in Communication from Fort Hays State University, and holds a Master of Public Administration degree from Wichita State University. He has been married to Brenda for 26 years, and they have two children who attend Kansas State University.

Starkey's origins date back to 1930 when Hattie Starkey, a local teacher, recognized the fact that children with disabilities were not being offered the same educational opportunities as students without disabilities. What began as the Starkey School is now Starkey, Inc., one of the fifty largest employers in the region. Starkey facilitates the integration of adults with disabilities into our community.

People who have been authorized to receive community services have the ability to choose their preferred program, and cannot be rejected just because they may be very challenging to serve. Starkey has adapted to provide some very specialized program options – including behavioral health supports – that have changed lives in remarkable ways.

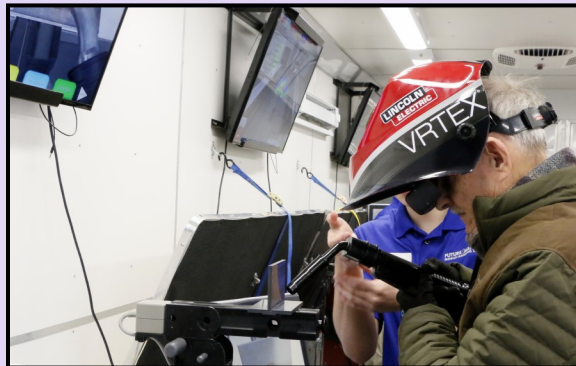
## ROTARY MEETING, JANUARY 14TH
